



Host District 2x1 Lions Clubs Blood Drives!

About

If each blood donation saves up to three lives, imagine how many you can save at your own blood drive. Hosting a blood drive gives you the chance to get your whole community involved and make an even bigger impact on the lives of others.

How It Works

- The District 2x1 Chair of Blood Donations (Gift of Life) notifies Carter Blood Care of their intention to run a blood drive
- The district chair will contact Carter BloodCare at 817-412-5384 (Donor Recruitment) or via email at bookablooddrive@carterbloodcare.org.
- A Carter Blood Care consultant is assigned, based on location/zip code of drive location
- The district chair will then reach out to the appropriate club president with name and contact information of their assigned consultant
- The Consultant will work with their contact to ensure there is time to set up and run a successful blood drive. Ideally, that takes 60-90 days, though we can set drives up in the short term as demand warrants.

Tips to Make Your Blood Drive Successful

Set a Goal

Determine a reasonable amount of donors you hope show up to give.

Plan Early

Along with your Carter BloodCare consultant; begin working on the details of your drive and handing out the provided marketing materials.



Spread the Word

Through signs, word-of-mouth, emails and more, let others near you know what is going on.

Start Signing Up Donors

send an email to anyone interested to give and have them sign up for a time slot. Don't worry; walk-ins are always welcome to donate.

Get a Group Involved

Get people to help you set up and get others excited. Have your team help you come up with unique ways to make your drive even more fun.

Show your Appreciation

at your drive; make sure every donor knows how much it means to you that they showed up.
